




CUSTOMER EXPERINCE PORTFOLIO: Structure

ANALYTICS PROGRAM:: Insights 17.4



- •100% Complete. No Spill Overs.
- •All Critical stories are completed in this Sprint.

Sprint 2

- •100% Complete. No Spill Overs.
- •4 Critical Stories are completed in this sprint, which make 60% Critical stories are already delivered and 50% release is already done.

- •100% Complete. No Spill Overs.
- •All Critical stories are already Accepted by PO, so that's a good news. So less risk involved in delivering the entire release scope.
- •75% of the whole scope as per release Base line is already completed.

Sprint 4

- •This Sprint is in Starting phase. And 75% is already completed.
- •All Critical & 50% of HIGH Priority Stories already delivered. But SP4 has highest number of stories compared to rest of the 3 Sprints. That's a LOW Risk area.
- Have less impact on the product launch.







Epic Level Completion %





1. Sprint Completion Percentage 12.5%. Spill Over Rate 87.5% . There are no Critical stories in SP3. Sprint is over but only 1 story is delivered in this sprint. 4. 4 High Priority Stories are there. And only 2 of them is Ready-for-PO. The rest 2 are still in Development-in-Progress. **HIGH RISK**. Stories are already spilled Over. 4 No of Spilled Over stories in SP3 is 7, among them 4 are HIGH Priority Stories. Among them only 4 are Readyfor-PO. If we assume, they will be Accepted-By-PO, still there are 3 stories which are Spilled Over in this Sprint

1. Among all Sprints, Sprint 4 has highest number of Critical Stories. 6 Counts. 2. All of them are (67%) Stories are only Review Ready. **HIGH RISK** in completion of Sprint. 3. No stories are in Testing Complete Status.


> 4. Development not yet started for any other stories in Parallel. Only 1 Story is Dev Complete at present.



Insights: SP1 & SP2 are already completed. But SP1 & 2 only has 7 stories with Low priority which is only 25% of the total Project. All high priority stories are from SP3 & SP4 and they also contain 75% i.e. 21 stories they have.






Insights: All Critical & High Priority Stories are delivered. So Less risk involved.



DIGITAL PROGRAM

As Desktop Project is in HIGH RISK ZONE, with 26% Spill Over Rates and Critical Stories pending, the overall **DIGITAL Portfolio** is at RISK, though Project Mobile has completed all the Critical Work Items.

ANALYTICS PROGRAM

Project Analytics is on LOW RISK as All Critical Stories Complete. **Best Project** compared all of them. Expected to be delivered on Time. Probable High Success Rate in Analytics Program.

CUSTOMER EXPERINCE PORTFOLIO

Almost half of the features of the entire portfolio is already delivered. But due to Project Desktop the entire portfolio might be in jeopardy.

Project Desktop 47% Done ~ HIGH RISK - Most Critical Stories Pending

Project Mobile 46% Done ~ LOW RISK - All Critical Stories Complete

Project Analytics

75% Done ~ Low Risk - All Critical Stories Complete. Best Project compared all of them. Expected to be delivered on Time.



Risk Mitigation Plans

More focus on *Project Desktop* - Complete the *Critical & High Priority Work Items*.

Need to <u>prioritize</u> Work Items based on Epics/Feature that are crucial for the overall Portfolio & Program. The PO needs to intervene here more to jump to a proper decision on which Work Items to be chosen first.

Project Analytics also required a focus as 50% of the Work Items also are undelivered.

Need to check the Spill Over rates on Sprint Level, identify the RCA and mitigate them asap.
